Cursillo helps us to...

- Grow into a deeper relationship with God through the person of Jesus Christ.
- Discover our vocation and develop our individual gifts for Christian service and leadership.
- Become more effective witnesses to Christ in our lives.
- Bring about and strengthen Christian commitment within a community of faith.
- Build up the witness of the Church in the world, that both may be renewed and transformed.

The Cursillo method is built on three fundamental principles - piety (prayer), study and action - all of which are explored in detail on the weekend and which inform our activity afterwards.

What is Cursillo?

Cursillo is a weekend event during which Christians explore their faith in all its dimensions in a prayerful and supportive environment. The name comes from Spanish - a 'short course' - and is pronounced 'kur-see-yo' for this reason.

Cursillo is also a way of life, something that might begin months or years before a person's attendance at the weekend and in which they may be involved for the rest of their life. It's led jointly by lay and ordained Christians.

Where have you been able to work for the coming of God's Kingdom?

At home? At work? In the community? Within your church or Cursillo?

What plans can you make to take action - alone or together? How can you pray for each other? **Study**

What has helped you understand more of God?

It might have been: Scripture reading; theological or other books; nature; art or music; video or film; lecture or sermon, etc.
